

## Leaderboards Information

Allstars Poker uses a point system as a method of qualifying into the Main Event and Aussie Millions Playoff Game. These points are used for Venue Leaderboards.

Each venue, each night has its own leaderboard. Each leaderboard must run for half the season to be in effect. Points are rewarded to top 9 players at each game for the length of the season.

At the end of the season points will be cleared and restarted ready for next season. Players will be awarded points with the following format.

1<sup>st</sup> 100

2<sup>nd</sup> 80

3<sup>rd</sup> 70

4<sup>th</sup> 60

5<sup>th</sup> 55

6<sup>th</sup> 50

7<sup>th</sup> 45

8<sup>th</sup> 40

9<sup>th</sup> 35



Players with the most points will be awarded qualification for that season game.

### TIE BREAK SYSTEM

In the event of points being equal for qualification, qualification will then go by the player who has won more games in that season for that night.

On occasion if both points and number of games won are equal, qualification then will be awarded to the player who has played more games for that season on that night.

If after the first 2 options players are still equal, we will break the ticket into 4 fractions. We will refer to the fraction list and divide the fractions between the players in question.

Leaderboards must run for a Minimum 6wks of the current season for the leaderboard points to be live and rewards to be rewarded to the player/s.
